

BIO:

Little Known Facts, a co-lead project presented by two Israeli musicians living in the Netherlands. Eran Har Even and Itai Weissman have been working together for the past 8 years in different formations and with this project drawn attention by the use of electronic sound effects and combined contemporary musical styles, delivering you a full hyper jazz experience!

Itai Weissman presents the future of wind instruments with his innovative playing on the AKAI EWI (Electric Wind Instrument), growing beyond the sound barriers of electronic vs. acoustic, creating a whole new identity and musical language that has never been heard before.

Eran Har Even is the "silent conductor" who is reinventing the function of the guitar in the neo-jazz genre, combining intellectual harmonic progression with sound textures from out of space.

Both Itai and Eran are faculty members at the Conservatory of Amsterdam, The Netherlands.

Aside his outstanding bass playing Pol Belardi (Luxembourg) adds with his multi instrumental skills synth bass modules and keyboards to strengthen the overall production sound.

Jeroen Batterink's (Netherlands) advanced rhythm concepts bring the fire which glues all the pieces together. The two of them make the final ingredient that completes the band.

The group met at the Conservatory of Amsterdam and since their first rehearsal date they knew what they must do...

In January 2014 the group recorded their debut album at the Power Sound Studio with personal consulting of sound engineer Ruben Kiftenbelt, master engineer Nate Wood and illustration designer Max Philippi.

In June 2014 the album was released to the media and got tremendous recognition from the public and the press.

Today Little Known Facts is one of the most promising projects in the neo-jazz style.

LITTLE KNOWN FACTS

Technical Rider

Line up:

Itai Weissman – Tenor sax / EWI

- *1 dynamical microphone (for example: Shure sm 58 or RE 20 electro voice)
- *1 stereo DI (for the EWI)
- *1 electricity socket

Eran Har Even – Guitar

- *Fender twin or deluxe amplifier (if there is no amp he will bring Polytone Brut), let us know if there are other available guitar amplifiers
- *3 isolated electricity sockets

Pol Belardi – E.Bass / Keyboards

- *Aguiar or Mark bass amplifier (if there is no amp he will bring Aguiar head and speaker)
- *3 isolated electricity sockets
- *1 stereo DI

Jeroen Batterink – Drums

- * a good drum set (please let us know which one)

Monitors :

1 for each band member (4 in total)

Sound check:

Not less then 30 minutes
